- Our ELT team (exec and committee) ranked #2 in Campus Relay fundraising teams raising \$66,581!



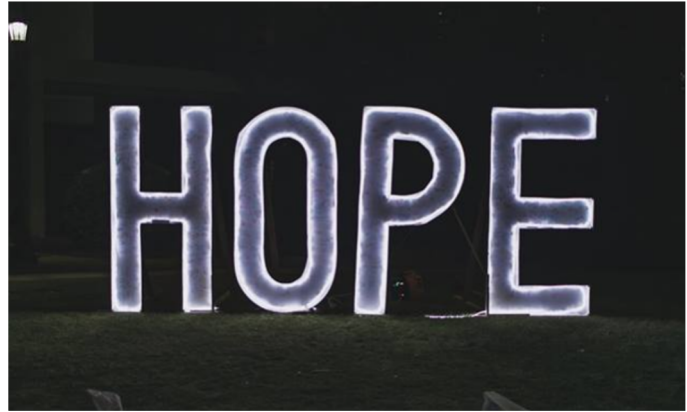
# Why you should get involved

- Register as an individual (can add you to a team later!)



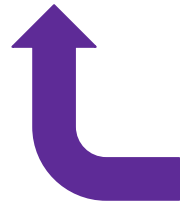
